California Environmental Reporting System (CERS)

Effective 2013, all regulated businesses must use the statewide, web-based reporting system, known as California Environmental Reporting System (CERS), to replace the paper forms they previously submitted to local regulatory agencies. **The Reynolds Group (TRG)** can prepare, manage, upload, and maintain CERS documentation. TRG can also maintain your CERS account with the local program agency and inform you of changes that affect you and your business activities.

The benefits of having TRG manage your CERS account include:

- **Convenience:** TRG assembles, prepares, organizes, and submits CERS data/forms for you.
- **Compliance:** TRG works with local agencies daily. TRG will submit documents to their standards.
- **Confidence:** TRG has been in business for 25 years. All of your documentation can be stored on TRG servers.

CERS is mandatory. Paperless filing is no longer an option. E-filing through CERS allows local regulatory agencies to collect and verify data related to the State's environmental programs. What must be reported?

- All hazardous materials business plans and site maps
- Regulated chemical inventories
- Hazardous waste related data
- Underground and aboveground tank data

Emergency response teams will eventually have access to essential information in the CERS database to assist them with response actions.
